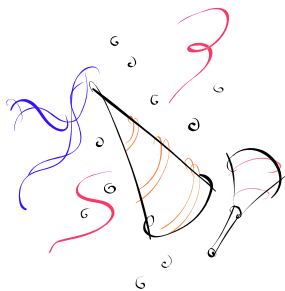
You must enter and leave the park as a Unit.
