



Award Criteria

The “Spirit of Hilda Leighton” Southern Vancouver Island Award

PURPOSE

The “Spirit of Hilda Leighton” SVI Award is a tribute to Guiders in SVI who reflect Hilda’s extraordinary innovative, pioneering and dedicated spirit for the joy of Guiding. As founder of Girl Guides in Victoria, her inspiration from the Crystal Palace Rally lives on in perpetuity with this award. The purpose is to recognize those Guiders who display the same qualities and devotion Hilda showed throughout her Guiding life.

ELIGIBILITY

A registered adult Guider who has:

- Been a registered member for a minimum of five years in SVI
- Given dedicated service exceeding expectations
- Continually given her best to Guiding
- Made a unique or memorable contribution in SVI
- Exhibited the true “Spirit of Guiding”

This award can only be earned in SVI Area and a Guider may receive this award pin only once.

NOMINATION

Each candidate requires two nominators accompanied by two completed nomination forms describing specific examples why she should receive this award.

Submit both nomination forms and an R3 form to the SVI Awards committee at least six weeks prior to presentation date.

APPROVAL

Consideration by the SVI Awards committee and Area Commissioner(s).

PRESENTATION

By a parent Council, Awards committee or Commissioner at District, Area or Provincial level.
