SVI AREA MONEY TALK - Gillian Hurwood (SVI Area Treasurer, acting)

I would like to thank all of you for your patience as we move to Unified Banking. For a variety of reasons, this has not happened as quickly as we had all hoped, once we started the process. Special thanks to the Champions (Eva Herbert and Nancy Fischer) who worked with me to provide training to Unit and District Treasurers. The Champions team is always available to answer your questions or provide trainings to new Treasurers or any Guider who might be interested. The team can be reached at sviub2020@gmail.com

So, where are we now? As of this writing, most of the Units and Districts have provided the bank with the information required to close the accounts. To save on bank charges, we had all the Units rolled into the District and then funds will be deposited by the Districts and transferred back to the Units. We are hopeful that the District funds will be provided to us this week.

What comes next? As soon as Units have their funds in place, expenses can be reimbursed and the Purchase Cards should arrive. If your unit does not yet have a Purchase Card holder(s), talk to your Treasurer and make arrangements to set one up. A Purchase Card is a Visa card in the name of a specific Guider (cannot be shared) with a monthly credit limit of \$300 (can be changed). Your Treasurer will be able to explain how the Purchase Card works and provide you with direction on submitting your receipts.

We can also reimburse 'manual expense claims' for those Guiders who are not Purchase Card holders. These should be submitted to your Treasurer with an expense claim form (new one uploaded on SVI Area website under COMMITTEES/Financial - https://www.svigirlguides.bc.ca/financial). The best way to use the expense claim is to fill it in on your computer and let the computer do all the work.

Some questions we have been asked along the way

- 1. **How will cookie money work?** If you are selling your cookies direct (not online) GGC National will advise you how much you owe for cookies and the date that the amount will be removed from your account. If you are selling them online, it is my understanding that your share will be deposited to your account at the close of the campaign.
- 2. **How will we pay for camp use?** On a regular basis, our Area Camp Treasurer will provide a list to GGC National of what each unit owes to which property (based on the information you submit after your rental). National will tell you how much and when they are removing the money from your account.
- 3. Can we do ATM or business banking deposits? Not at present.
- 4. **How do we get parents set up to pay bills?** Your Treasurer will be able to provide you with a form for each parent to use which has directions on setting up online bill payment. Each parent will need the Unit's Banking ID and their child's iMIS number.
- 5. What is the quickest way to get reimbursed for an expense? Complete the direct deposit form in MemberZone. Go to Guider Resources-Unified Banking to locate the form. Send it to the email address at the bottom of the form. When you submit an expense claim, have your Treasurer indicate in the comments that you are set up for direct deposit and give them your iMIS number.
