



**MAIN FLOOR**

- ❖ Sleeping, eating and activities are accommodated in the large hall with an additional small meeting room upstairs
- ❖ Washroom facilities but no showers.
- ❖ Maximum overnight capacity is 24 people (youth & adults)
- ❖ Free parking available for a maximum of 2 vehicles in the “Loading Zone” area in front of the main entrance between noon on Fridays until 8:00am on Mondays. All other vehicles must park on Monterey Avenue. The Oak Bay Fire Department runs daily training, Monday to Friday mornings from 8:00am-Noon when there is no parking allowed by the public in the whole parking lot during that time frame.
